

Fifth Grade Reading Log Menu

Ideas for fiction books:

- Write a review of your book (5 stars or thumbs up/down) with an explanation of your rating.
- Write a journal entry from the perspective of a character.
- Write a letter from one character to another.
- Would you like to live during the time period of your book? Why or Why not?
- Research a topic that comes up in your book and write an article about it.
- Propose a better title for the book.
- Propose a better ending for the book.
- Which character is the bravest, fairest, wisest, etc?
- How have the characters changed during the story?
- Would you read other books by this author? Why or Why not?
- Write a letter to the author to critique the book or ask questions.

Ideas for Non-fiction books:

- Write a review of your book (5 stars or thumbs up/down) with an explanation of your rating.
- After reading the book what else would you like to learn about the topic?
- What special techniques did the author use to keep you interested?
- What text features were used in the book? What else could have been added to make it better?
- Write an article telling others interesting information you learned from reading the book.
- Would you read other books by this author?
- Write a letter to the author of the book critiquing the book or asking questions.
